

Provincial Outreach Program for Early Intervention – POPFASD

The Provincial Outreach Program for Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (POPFASD) is a British Columbia Ministry of Education Provincial Outreach Program and has been in existence since 2006.

POFASD provides services to educators in BC schools by sharing current research, strategies, training and resources about Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD). They provide in-services, workshops and eLearning moduels to help build teacher capacity to educate students living with FASD.

Their mandate is to:

- Provide support and training for educators of students living with FASD.
- Build district capacity to support and serve FASD students in their home school districts.
- Provide online access to information, eLearning videos, resources and training.
- Synthesize and share current research and successful practices to support students with FASD.
- Share knowledge and practice.
- Liaise with District Partners in each school district, the Ministry of Children and Family Development, the Ministry of Health, and the multi-district Steering Committee.

The POPFASD team is located in the Prince George School District but they serve the entire province.
